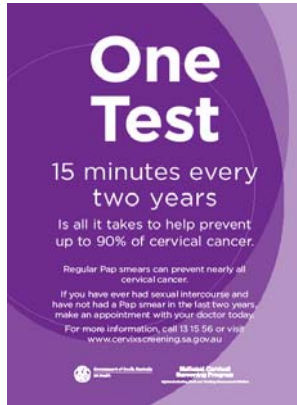

## Pap Smear Awareness Week 2-8 May 2010 Community Small Grants

**Community Small Grants** are available as part of Pap smear Awareness Week 2-8 May 2010. The grants assist community and health workers to conduct promotional activities in their local communities.

### Target Groups

Pap Smear Awareness Week promotes and encourages all women aged 18 – 70 to have two yearly Pap smears. Target groups for 2010 are:

- Low socioeconomic and isolated rural areas;
- Culturally and Linguistically Diverse communities;
- Women 30-45 years of age in under screened areas;
- Women over 60 years of age in under screened areas;
- Women with disabilities;

### How much is the grant worth?

Community Small grants of \$500 are available.

### When should the activity be conducted?

Pap Smear Awareness Week activities are between Sunday 2 May and Saturday 8 May 2010.
