TRAINING MODULE & CD

Rules about sex: getting them right

This CD-based resource has been produced to assist workers and parents to assess knowledge and teach the rules about sexual behaviour and strategies for sexual safety and improved relationships.

The main aims are to:

- help reduce sexual victimisation of people with disability
- help reduce the incidence of sexual behaviours which may cause offence to others
- prevent vulnerable people with a disability from involvement with the law and possible long-term consequences of this.



The CD will only be available to individuals who have undergone a training module with SHine SA. This module will emphasise sensitive and ethical use of the resource and its images as well as practical application to solving the educational needs of individuals. Suitable participants include: police, parents, disability advocates, service coordinators, special education workers and therapists.

The CD contains a printable manual including information sheets that help interpret South Australian laws about sexual behaviour in plain English using CAN and SHOULD NOT statements. These relate to consent, age of consent, private places, safer sex, sexual harassment, sexual abuse, rape and incest. Each section contains a series of possible questions and answers to support discussion.

The CD also contains a series of line drawings which can be used individually, in sequence, or combined electronically to create new resources which are tailored to individual needs.

Each participant will need to bring a fully charged laptop computer loaded with MS Word or MS Powerpoint.
