## How To Apply Through SATAC

Applications for undergraduate and coursework postgraduate Aboriginal Studies and Australian Studies programs are submitted through the South Australian Tertiary Admissions Centre (SATAC). Applications are made online using SATAC's web based resource called *UniWeb*.

To enter *UniWeb*, go to [www.satac.edu.au](http://www.satac.edu.au) and click on the blue 'Uni' button.  
Next click:

- The 'Undergraduate admissions - Semester 1, 2011' button for undergraduate applications and,
- 'GradStart – Jan to Nov 2011' button for post graduate applications.

## Key SATAC Dates

- Thursday 30 September 2010 – apply for undergraduate programs by this date to avoid paying a late fee. Apply for postgraduate programs by December
- Friday 3 December, 2010 - equal consideration closing date. New applications after this date are not guaranteed equal consideration for selection. Check with SATAC before applying after this date.
- Wednesday 5 January, 2011. Deadline for existing applicants to change their preferences to most courses and still be guaranteed equal consideration.

## When are offers posted?

- Thursday 13 January, 2011 – Main January offer round letters posted. Offer information available on *UniWeb* after 6.00pm
- Monday 24<sup>th</sup> January, 2011 – Late January offer round letters posted. Offer information available on *UniWeb* after 6.00pm
- Thursday 3 February, 2011 – February offer round letters posted. Offer information available on *UniWeb* after 6.00pm.

## Application Fees

- **Processing Fee:**  
Current Yr 12 students - \$19.00  
All other applicants - \$45
- **Late Fees:**  
New applications lodged after Thursday 30 September, 2010 must pay a late fee in addition to the processing fee:

Current Yr 12 students:  
\$86 in addition to the processing fee (\$105 in total)  
All other applicants:  
\$86 in addition to the processing fee (\$131 in total)

## STAT Test (Special Entry)

- **How to book for a STAT Test**

When you apply through SATAC on *UniWeb* you will be asked if you want to sit for the Special Entry or STAT Test. Depending when you apply you will be given a choice of venues and dates. Your booking is confirmed when you pay the fees owing for the STAT.

To be eligible for special entry:

- You must be 18 years or over before 1 February, 2011 and
- Must not have been enrolled in a program leading to a higher education level award in 2009 or 2010 for any period of time.
