The Disability and Arts Transition Team (DATT) and the Community Arts Network of SA Inc. (CAN SA) invite Deaf, Auslan users to join in training that contributes to a **Course in Business Skills for Creative People** (Code 40594SA).

Only 12 places are available for Deaf, Auslan users to take part.

Initially the training will be delivered over two days (10am to 4pm each day) and is nationally accredited. If you successfully complete the course you will be awarded a Statement of Attainment that is nationally recognised.

**No prior qualifications are needed for you to undertake this workshop.**

The training aims to

- ⇒ Improve your skills and capabilities
- ⇒ Boost project management quality
- ⇒ Offer opportunities to network and share ideas
- ⇒ Learn in an environment that supports Auslan
- ⇒ Build your self esteem, confidence and knowledge.

The training opportunity will offer participants the opportunity to earn qualifications in two modules within a Course in Business Skills for Creative People (Code 40594SA). It is a nationally recognised program for people who volunteer and work in the arts, cultural and community sector in regional Australia..

The units **The People Factor** (CUTPH08B) and **Plan and Program Events** (CVPPE06B) will be offered in Auslan over three days (16-18 November 2011) between 10am and 4pm each day. Workshops are hands on, practical and designed to be relevant to participants.

If you are an Artist, arts worker, volunteer, someone who works within communities or someone who would like to, this course is for you. DATT is able to support participants further by offering this course at a fee of on \$25 per module (it can cost up to \$150).
