CALLING ALL ARTISTS!!

The upcoming Port Adelaide Rotary Art Show is calling for entries from local artists as part of its 25th exhibition.

Art Show Director David Hunter says it's a great opportunity for artists to showcase their work to art lovers and help a deserving cause with the entry fee and commission going to a range of charities.

"Last year we sold more than \$21,000 worth of paintings over four days and raised \$8,000 for charity. With more than 1000 visitors, it's one of the biggest art shows in metropolitan Adelaide," said David.

"Rotary takes a 25% commission on the sale of each work of art which is contributed to a range of local and international charities and the artist gets the rest.

"Anyone can enter a painting or photographic art – it's our 25th year this year so we want to make it the best Port Adelaide Rotary Art Show yet," said David.

Categories in this year's Art Show include the open section, port and maritime, artists with a disability, photographic art and several youth categories.

This year, there is \$8000 in prize money on offer with the top prize being \$3,500 for first prize in the open category.

"Artists can enter a maximum of five artworks and we really encourage young artists to take part, with our three youth categories, under 18 years, under 15 years and the under 10 years," said David.

"We are looking forward to having a huge variety of paintings, drawings and photographic art. Whether you're an aspiring or established artist we would love to hear from you," said David.

The closing date for entries is 25 November, with the exhibition running from 29 December 2011 to 2 January 2012 at the PortLife Church on Causeway Road, Newport.
